

Beloved,

Easter is a little bit early this year, March 31st . It can actually be as early as March 22nd , but still March 31st is on the earlier side. If you're curious about why the date changes, it's because the date of Easter is based on a lunar calendar. Easter is the first Sunday after the full moon on or following the spring equinox. It can fall between March 22nd and April 25th.

Easter is the heart of our faith as Christians and our Holy Week and Easter celebrations make up the heart of our liturgical year. All our worship is grounded in the Triduum, the three great days of Holy Week, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil. If you have not taken part in these services I encourage you to do so this year. They can stand alone if you can only make one or two of them, but they are best experienced together. In fact, some people understand the three services to not be distinct separate services but pieces of one great service.

If you ask regular attendees of the Triduum services they will agree that these are some of the most moving and powerful things we do together at St. John's. All this is to say that our worship on these days is not just important in a theological sense but also important in our lived experience of our faith. If you were to tell me you only could join us for three days of the year I would tell you to come to these three days.

This year I invite you to join us as we walk Holy Week together in our Triduum services. On Thursday, March 28th in our Maundy Thursday service we will remember Christ's final commandment to us, that we love one another as he loves us, and his institution of the Last Supper. On Friday we will remember the pain and sacrifice of his crucifixion with our Good Friday liturgy. And on Saturday after the sun has set we will gather together to light a new fire on the front steps and bear the light from that fire into the dark church where we will hear stories of God's saving deeds throughout our history before we begin our Easter celebration flooding the church with light and music and joy.
