

Beloved in Christ,

As I am writing this I am two weeks away from beginning my sabbatical time. As was shared in last months Tower in our Diocese clergy are eligible to take three months of sabbatical after five years of service. In the fourteen years I have been serving as a priest in our diocese this will be my first time on sabbatical. Three months seems a bit much all at once to me so I have opted to split the time over this summer and next.

This years time will begin on Monday, June 9th and run until Sunday, August 4th . During this month and a half I will be working on a nonprofit finance class offered by RIC as part of their Graduate Certificate in Nonprofit Management program; I will travel to Kentucky on behalf of our diocese as the chair of our diocesan deputation to General Convention; I will spend a lot of time with my family hopefully most of which will be at the beach but also including a trip to Maine to with my siblings and parents to celebrate my Dad's birthday, and a trip to Ohio for a cousin's wedding; and I will attempt to undertake what I'm calling a parish pilgrimage where I will try to prayerfully walk as many, if not all, the streets in Barrington.

I chose to split this time and take it over the summer to hopefully minimize the disruption to our Parish life. There will of course be some disruptions but hopefully they'll be small. Things that rely upon me during the week will not be taking place. Our Monday Bible Study will finish up reading the Acts of the Apostles on Monday, June 3rd and will resume in the fall for a nine or ten week survey of topics in theology. Our weekday morning services, daily Morning Prayer and the Wednesday Eucharist, will be on hold following Thursday, June 6th until Monday August 5th .

I'm working out how we can continue Compline on Wednesday in the Memorial Garden so that will hopefully continue in person, although it will not be streamed this summer. Our weekly Tuesday morning Coffee Hour and Thursday Happy Hour on Zoom will continue as long as people show up. Finally, with the exception of the times that I am out of town, when I am in Kentucky for General Convention and Maine with my family, I will be available for any pastoral emergencies. The weeks I am away Jennifer Zogg, the rector of Epiphany, Rumford, will be on call for us. In the event of any emergency please reach out to the office and Dale will get you in touch with either Jennifer or myself.
